#### A WORD FROM THE FROZEN MEAL MANAGER

Hello everyone, every month we deliver frozen meals. At this time, we contact all beneficiaries registered for the service to verify their needs. The next delivery dates are **April 19, 2024, May 17, 2024, June 14, 2024, July 12, 2024 and August 9, 2024**. If you run out of meals between deliveries, you can contact us to to order. We will schedule a delivery to your home. Also, you or a member of your family can come directly to our offices to pick up your meals. Please note that due to limited meal inventory, we may have to offer a maximum quantity of dishes. The demand for the service is constantly increasing, we do our best to meet the needs of as many people as possible.

As for payment, it must be made in <u>cash</u> or by <u>check</u> made out to <u>Vision Gaspé-Percé Now</u>. If you do not have the exact amount upon delivery, an invoice will be sent to you at the end of the month to avoid errors on our part. Starting **April 1st**, there will be a change in meal prices. <u>Soups and desserts will be \$1</u>, while main meals will be \$4.

I would like to thank all the volunteers involved in serving frozen meals. There are approximately 45 volunteers who get involved throughout the year in all areas of the service (cooking, meal packaging, delivery preparation and delivery). Your involvement is valuable to us. Thank you for everything!
