*A WORD FROM THE FROZEN MEAL MANAGER **

Hello to all,

Every month, we deliver frozen meals. At this time, we contact all beneficiaries registered for the service to verify their needs. The next delivery dates are **July 11, 2024, August 15, 2024, September 13, 2024, October 11, 2024, November 15, 2024, and December 13, 2024**. If you run out of meals between deliveries, you can contact us to place an order. We will schedule a delivery to your home. Also, you or a member of your family can come directly to our offices to pick up your meals. Please note that due to limited meal inventory this summer, we may have to offer a maximum quantity of dishes.

As for payment, it must be made in **cash** or by **check** made out to **Vision Gaspé-Percé Now**. If you do not have the exact amount upon delivery, an invoice will be sent to you at the end of the month to avoid errors on our part. **Soups and desserts are now \$1, while main meals are \$4**.

My contract with CAB ends at the beginning of August as I am going to continue my studies at the University of Sherbrooke. I am happy to have met you and to have gotten involved in my community. I am handing over to the next person responsible for frozen meals who will be introduced to you shortly.

This communication channel will allow us to send a monthly mailing instead of several email communications. We invite you to take the time to read it, important information will be found there. Jebenevole.ca is the provincial platform for matching CABs and non-profit organizations (NPOs) with volunteers. It presents volunteer offers with search tools and filters allowing matching between organizations and individuals in order to fill volunteer human resources. Organizations that wish to do so can create an account on this platform, in order to recruit volunteers for their activities. In addition, Jebenevole.ca offers the **free** option of carrying out criminal background checks (VAJ) for volunteers working with community organizations and voluntary associations. More specifically, this program to cover VAJ costs is aimed at volunteers who work with a clientele said to be at risk of experiencing abuse by others, whether due to their physical and/or mental condition, or other temporary or permanent circumstances.

FREE VACCINATION FOR SHINGLES

The Minister of Health, Christian Dubé, as well as the Minister for Seniors and Health, Sonia Bélanger, announce the enhancement of the Quebec Immunization Program with the addition of **free vaccination** against shingles for Quebecers and Quebecers aged 75 and over and for immunocompromised people aged 18 and over. The goal of the program is to reduce the number of cases of shingles and associated complications. This is a further step in prevention, one of the key elements of the Health Plan presented a year ago by Minister Dubé. This is a first step in reaching vulnerable people first. The program may be enhanced in the coming years to broaden the age groups who will be able to benefit from free shingles vaccine.
